LIFETIME CARE CONTRACT

This constitutes a contract by and between Cat Care Society, a nonprofit Colorado Corporation formed for charitable purposes (CAT CARE) and the undersigned owner of a cat or cats, which owner desires to enter into this contract for the mutually agreed upon consideration as stated hereafter.

Cat Care agrees to assume custody of the owner's cat (s) at such time as the owner is unwilling or unable to provide continued care for the cat (s), due to the desire, disability or death of the owner. In accepting custody, Cat Care shall provide the animal (s) appropriate health care, feeding, shelter, veterinary services, adoption or placement of the animal (s) in a appropriate setting, and if such becomes necessary, euthanasia for relief of suffering. By virtue of this contract, Cat Care may not refuse acceptance of the animal (s); however, it shall use its best corporate judgment as to the care, adoption or disposition of the animal (s).

In consideration for these services to be rendered, the owner agrees to tender payment to Cat Care in the amount of \$_____ dollars (no less that \$2,500.00 per cat), effective at such time as Cat Care takes possession of the cat (s). A deposit shall be placed with Cat Care at the time of the execution of this contract in the amount of at least \$100.00 dollars per cat, which sum shall be credited to the remaining sum at the time of transfer of possession of the cat (s). This initial deposit is agreed to be a reasonable and necessary administrative expense in preparation for that time when this contract is fully satisfied, and as such, the initial deposit is non-refundable.

This contract shall apply and bind Cat Care and any of its lawful successors of similar charitable purposes; and this contract shall be binding upon the owner, his agents, guardians, heirs or Estate Administrators. This contract shall be interpreted and enforced under the laws of the State of Colorado. Cat Care, in its sole discretion, may seek to enforce its provisions through arbitration or through the Courts of the City and County of Denver.
