A letter from our Executive Director

I look back at 2025 with gratitude for our Cat Care Society community of donors, volunteers, adopters, board, and staff who came together to achieve meaningful success for cats in Colorado. Together, we supported cat lovers throughout our community through our adoptions, Temporary Care, Nibbles and Kibbles food bank, Nine Lives Legacy Society and Guardianship Program, and free educational programs.

Over the last three years, we've made significant progress in refining our policies, procedures, and best practices to strengthen shelter operations and outcomes. Since 2022, intake has increased by 79% (including an 83% increase in cats over the age of 8), while adoptions have grown by 49% and cats cared for through our Temporary Care Program has increased by 42%. During that same period, in-shelter euthanasia decreased by 15%. We've also reduced our average length of stay from 58 days to just 32 – getting cats into loving homes faster while maintaining high standards of care. These improvements reflect a clear and positive shift in how we care for and support cats at every stage of their journey.

As we look ahead to 2026, we celebrate these successes while remaining committed to growth and continuous improvement. Thank you for joining us in our mission to be a safe and enriching place for all cats on their journey to a loving home.

A letter from our Board of Directors

It has been another incredible year at Cat Care Society, providing care and support for over 1000 cats on their way to loving homes. It's been particularly rewarding to witness many "Lonely Hearts Club" cats – who are often older or require special care – adopted into new homes. And let's not forget little Curry! This exceptional paraplegic cat stole hearts locally and online before being adopted into a loving home. Achievements like these were made possible through the dedication of our staff, volunteers, fosters, donors, and adopters.

CCS is unique in its mission and operation, including our free-roam environment and our dedication to all cats regardless of age or ability. Many cats come to us with serious medical conditions. While these cats may not have a chance elsewhere, we don't shy away from such challenges. Our veterinary team provides vital medical care and adoption counseling to help these cats move into caring homes.

Other cats come to us with behavior challenges, needing time and space to relax and build trust. Our staff and volunteers, including feline behavior specialists, engage with cats daily to ensure their comfort and enrichment. It is so rewarding to see these cats blossom into confident, loving kitties ready to move on to loving homes.

We could not be more proud of our entire team – intake, animal care, adoption, veterinary, fosters, volunteers, and others – each dedicated to the cats at CCS.

We could not do any of this without your support. Thank you!

What is the Lonely Hearts Club?

Our “Lonely Hearts” are special cats that need a little extra spotlight to show just how much we love them! These cats are often our longest stays, overlooked due to their age, medical or behavioral needs, or because they are not quite as eye-catching as other cats in the shelter. They may have been overlooked in the past, but we believe they have so much love to give to the right home.

At CCS, we believe **ALL** cats are worthy, regardless of age or ability, and we are proud to take on some of the most challenging medical and behavioral cases that other shelters don't have the resources to care for. Because of our amazing donor support, we are able to take in these cats and give them the time and care they need to heal and become a candidate for adoption.

200+ medical conditions were diagnosed and/or treated by CCS staff this year!

Meet Xochitl

Adoptions

At CCS, we are committed to connecting cats with people who love them. We believe all cats are worthy of love and provide comprehensive medical care, enrichment and socialization to every animal that comes through our doors — even, and perhaps especially, to seniors and cats with special needs. We work with shelter partners across the state to provide homes for cats who may not have a chance elsewhere and accept owner surrenders without judgment.

1,280 cats and kittens came into our care. 55% were transferred from 27 Colorado shelter partners.

1,105 cats were adopted out, including 181 seniors!

Temporary Care Program

The TCP helps people who are unable to care for their own cats for a short time due to unexpected circumstances. During times of crisis, it provides peace of mind by ensuring that beloved cats are safe, cared for, and ready to return home when their owners are able.

64 cats and their families were supported through our Temporary Care Program.

Nibbles & Kibbles

The Nibbles & Kibbles emergency food bank offers free cat food and supplies to people experiencing financial challenges. This helps owners continue to care for their cats, who may be one of their few comforts during times of hardship. The pantry is open for free to community members in need twice a month.

1,000 cats and 300 families were served through our emergency food pantry.

Volunteers

Volunteers are crucial to the success of Cat Care Society, providing invaluable support to our daily operations, direct care for cats, and community engagement. Their dedication allows us to care for more cats than we could on our own, multiplying our impact and helping even more animals find loving homes.

2,000 hours of service were provided by our volunteers, the equivalent of another full-time employee!

Foster Care

We believe that temporary homes lead to forever ones. Foster homes provide a calm, safe environment for cats who may not thrive in the shelter — whether recovering from surgery, needing space from other animals, fighting a contagious illness, or too young to be vaccinated. In foster care, cats receive individualized attention, enrichment, and loving care to grow, heal, and flourish, while also freeing up space in the shelter for more animals in need.

11,877 hours of compassionate foster care were provided for 323 cats.

Nine Lives Legacy Society

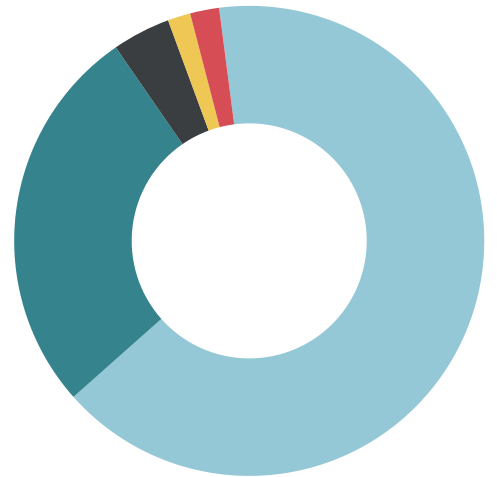
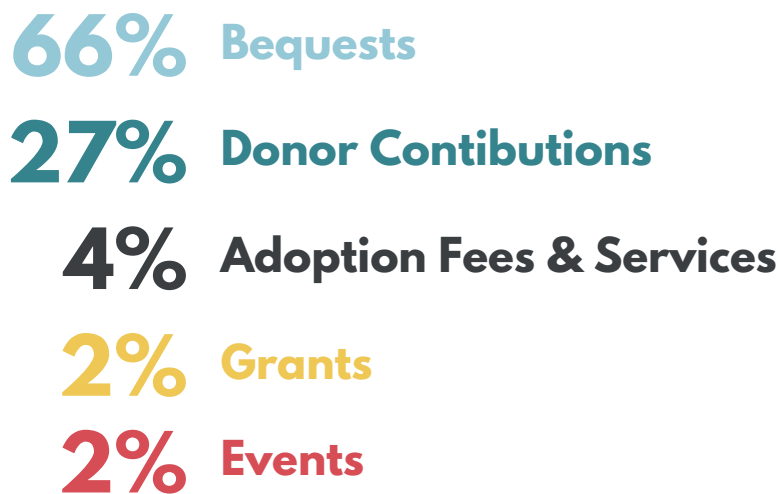
The Nine Lives Legacy Society gives donors the opportunity to partner with Cat Care Society to leave a legacy for the future of the organization and to secure care for their cats who are so deeply loved. All participants are invited to enroll their cats in the Guardianship Program. Should their cats survive them, CCS will serve as temporary guardian until they are adopted into their next loving home, offering valuable peace of mind.

197 families are currently enrolled in our Nine Lives Legacy Society.

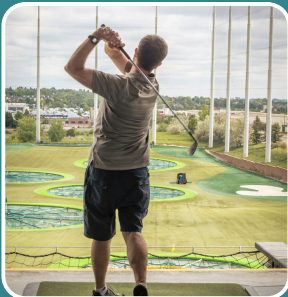
February 21

September 11 & October 29

October 8

Went viral (again!) with the heartwarming story of CCS Facilities Supervisor Pat who fell in love with Dun Dun Dun at a staff meeting and adopted him shortly after. The video reached over 12 million views across Instagram, TikTok, and Facebook.



October 14-16

Hosted over 100 students from Denver Public Schools during Vet Tech Week, providing education on careers in animal sheltering and hands-on experience.



October 18

Celebrated our 10th Anniversary Tails of the Painted Cats gala and art auction with our largest event ever including 224 guests in attendance and an additional 120 online bidders. The event raised over \$90,000 for CCS.



October 23

Began an off-site adoption partnership with PetSmart to provide more visibility to our adoptable cats at their University Hills location. In the first 2 months, 35 cats were adopted through this partnership.



December 9

Executed a record-breaking Colorado Gives Day, bringing in over \$193,000 from 1,300 donors. This marks our most successful online giving campaign in CCS history.
