The anonymous feedback you provided in that survey is providing crucial input for our upcoming strategic plan. We listened and are working hard on implementing more structure and some new changes to make sure that we are serving our community – and our cats – the best way possible.

As we wrap up our current fiscal year, which ends June 30, we have seen so many cats adopted into new homes (in fact, just so far this year, we're already over the total from last fiscal year!) and other shelter successes, we have even higher hopes for the future. As we look ahead, we are invigorated to unveil a refreshed mission statement, strategic goals, and initiatives to further engage our community and get more cats placed in homes. 

VOLUNTEER PROGRAM UPDATES



Volunteers are the backbone of Cat Care Society, providing invaluable support to our daily operations and care for cats while engaging the greater community. Without the help of our nearly 200 volunteers, we simply couldn't have the impact that we do. We are so grateful for every single person that has helped us throughout our 40-year history.

The volunteer program here has been strong for years, though COVID brought about some changes to the positions available to those giving their time. As our organization continues to evolve and adapt, we are excited to share a few updates to the volunteer program.

While most of the volunteer roles in the past have centered around hands-on caring for the cats and assisting at events, we have been working hard at finding new ways to engage volunteers and provide much-needed relief to our shelter staff. Some of these roles will leverage volunteers' time to serve as adoptions assistants, lobby attendants, phone support to check in with adopters, and offer professional skills. We now have a street team helping to help raise awareness of CCS, hanging posters around town and arranging fundraisers. We are also looking for a street team for our Catty Hour events to help recruit both host destinations and attendees, and raise further awareness.

Interested volunteers can also expect a new streamlined application process. Now, there will be set dates where applications are open for two weeks every other month, which allows time for onboarding and ensures volunteers start in groups, with tasks and staff ready to welcome them.

All new volunteers will also now go through formal trainings for cat handling and behavior and receive an updated handbook detailing rules and guidelines, plus individualized training for their role. We believe this will provide additional support for volunteers and set them up for success.

VOLUNTEERING AT CAT CARE SOCIETY AND EMPLOYER MATCHING

As a longtime volunteer at Cat Care Society, I was excited to learn about employer matching. Volunteering at CCS is wonderful for me because it combines my love of cats and helping the community, with flexible and varying opportunities to support CCS' needs. They have many different volunteer jobs to choose from. I enjoy working events to spread awareness about CCS, and delivering for the Nibbles 'n' Kibbles program. I have also served as an adoption assistant and nursing home visitor in the past. These are just some of the opportunities available. They always need folks to socialize with the cats, and what could be more fun?!

Employer matching is just an added benefit of my time spent volunteering at CCS. By reporting my volunteer hours to my employer, they are able to send a small grant each year to help CCS financially. In my case, after I reach 20 hours of volunteering at CCS and record them, my employer automatically sends the grant to CCS in my name. Many employers offer this type of benefit, so if you want to help the cats by volunteering, don't forget to check if your employer also offers this great program!

Do you work for a company that encourages philanthropic giving? Employers understand the importance of giving and, more importantly, understand that their employees care about the impact they can have in their community. Because of this, many employers offer a matching incentive and will double – sometimes triple – your donation!

WHERE ARE THEY NOW? -LUCCA-



We are always thrilled when some of the longer stay cats at the shelter find their forever homes, and one cat who certainly put in her time was none other than Lucca, aka Regina George. Lucca came into our care in August 2020, and in March 2023, finally found her human.

While at CCS, Lucca claimed her space at the front desk. Despite her disdain for other cats, (and even people), she didn't mind letting the public know that this was *her* domain. Lucca was in a foster home from one of our board members for a time, and when she returned to the shelter, staff thought it would be best to give Lucca her own space to reign freely, without the worry of anyone else bothering her. The idea to nickname her Regina George (from the popular movie *Mean Girls*) came when CCS staff held their weekly "Length of Stay" meeting, where they discuss tactics on getting CCS' longest-staying cats adopted. The character Regina is the queen of her school, charming people into doing whatever she wants, and isn't afraid to tell it like it is.

Not long after, an adopter came into the shelter looking for a cat just like Regina. Her new owner Rachel shared this update: "The adoption process was super quick and easy. I knew I wanted an older cat or one that had been at the shelter for a while, and [the adoptions staff] knew just the cat for me.

"Regina made herself at home in the first 30 minutes. She explored my apartment and was hopping on counters immediately! She loves chicken-flavored treats and cheese, being a troublemaker, drinking water straight from the faucet, sunbathing on her tower or window perch, laying in her bed or on my desk while I work, laying on my lap or the ottoman as we watch TV, and stealing my food when I'm not looking!

"You can pet her head, but she is not the biggest fan of being picked up. I get her to play for about 20 seconds, but she gets over that quickly. It takes her a bit to warm up to new people, but then she will cuddle with you all night long! She seems happy, and I'm so glad I adopted her!"


Update as of May 1, 2023: Oscar was recently brought home thanks to our Foster to Adopt (FTA) program. This program allows adopters to "foster" a cat for a period of time with the intention of adopting them. While in the program, cats receive medical treatment from our veterinary staff until they are ready to be officially adopted. The FTA program helps get cats out of the shelter environment faster, giving us the space to take in more cats that need our help!


